- Schedule, communicate and coordinate with customer field representative for start date, deliveries and construction progress.
- Set the sequence and assignment of work to minimize exposure to job site safety risks and to keep the installation on budget and on time
- Fill out necessary paperwork for materials and equipment delivery.
- Constantly monitor all aspects of the execution of the work: labor, material, schedule delays and additional mobilization.
- Visit all jobs in progress at least twice a week.
- Translate and interpret construction schematics to actual installation.
- Ensure NEC and UBC Code compliance on installation of all electrical and mechanical components.
- Coordinate and complete inspection items and warranty requirements.
- Fill out necessary paperwork for materials and equipment delivery
- Review of payroll and timely submission to department manager for approval.
- Review material/labor variance reports.
- WIP (work in progress) – updated with weekly payroll processing.
- Maintain updated calendar for current and upcoming jobs.
- Monitor installations with plans, specifications and manufacturers recommendations.
- Maintain consistent job-site cleanliness.
- Commission completed projects.
